## WT SmartCity Award 2014 \_ Avis Magica by Armarada




On April 9, at the inauguration of Milan Design Week, Palazzo Isimbardi was the setting for the award ceremony of the WT SmartCity Award 2014; the second edition of the international prize, stands as a showcase for the most innovative and visionary projects in the field of sustainability, design, accessibility and urban and architectural complexity.

One of the projects that we like more, is the architecture study of Armarada [http://www.armarada.com/]: Alex Sandulescu, Dan Adrian Ionescu and Catalina Simion, young professionists with a great desire to do something new and innovative to impress and make the quality of life better for everyone. Avis Magica, the name of their project in the race and with whom they won a special mention, is the better proof.

The project, sited in Miami, proposes the innovative concept of the vertical nature to contrast the actual problem of pollution. The building is divided in different parts: in the bottom we can find a 120 meter tall aquarium that filters water from the Ocean, the middle accommodates the green balconies that live thanks to the humidity from the water below that also creates the clouds and the rain that the building generates inside itself

Two big elevators run through the entire show to let the visitors to pass inside the aquarium and the sea life, inside the forest to see the vegetation area populated with a lot of variety of birds and, then, up until the artificial clouds at the observation's point.
