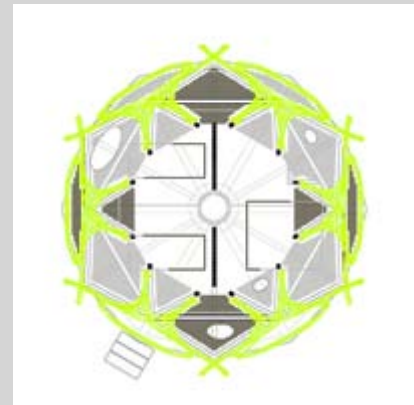
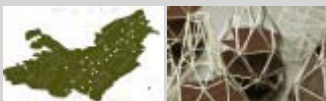

Self-sufficient house in Cauca Valley.

This experimental house based on a traditional scheme is made from bamboo, which grows naturally and in abundance in the area. Its slender figure becomes an organic element that rises over the landscape's valley. The bamboo shell, interwoven with wicker mesh, creates a hard-wearing structure.

Building area: 60 sqm per unit

Location: Cauca valley, Colombia
